**SUBJECT:** Bob Wiley, Tulare County Sheriff's Office Agriculture, and Mooney Grove Park Well Replacement Emergency

**REQUEST(S):**  
 That the Board of Supervisors:  
 Determine that the failure of three County wells located at the Bob Wiley Detention Facility and Mooney Grove Park originally taken to the Board of Supervisors on June 2, 2015 is a continuing emergency (4/5ths vote required).

**SUMMARY:**  
 On June 2, 2015, pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22050, the Board of Supervisors found the failure of three County wells due to severe drought conditions to be an emergency and directed staff to begin repairing those wells immediately. The three wells are as follows: one irrigation well and one domestic well at the Bob Wiley Detention Facility complex, and one irrigation/domestic well at Mooney Grove Park. Since approval, staff has selected Western Strata to complete all three well projects. The Mooney Grove agreement in the amount of \$341,099.34 was approved by the Board on July 28, 2015. A change order in the amount of \$122,925.51 was approved by the Board for the addition of a domestic pump. The Mooney Grove Park well is permitted and drilling was completed. The well casing was installed and then partially collapsed. The pump company tried to swage the casing, but the process did not work. Therefore, a new well needed to be drilled at no additional cost to the County. Currently, the well has been re-drilled, the steel casing has been installed, and the well has been developed. Southern California Edison still needs to review the additional power requirements of the new pumps and the pumps need to be installed.

**SUBJECT:** Bob Wiley, TCSO Agriculture, and Mooney Grove Park Well Replacement  
Emergency

**DATE:** November 17, 2015

The drilling and casing installation is complete on both Bob Wiley wells. The Ag well has been developed and the Southern California Edison (SCE) power review is under way. Once the review is complete the new pump will be installed. The domestic well did not produce enough water to meet the facility needs when originally drilled to 600 feet. Therefore, the decision was made to increase the depth of the well to 1,100 feet. This depth was chosen based upon additional well information from the surrounding area, as well as, a pilot hole drilled to 900 feet and the e-log results of the pilot hole. The domestic well has been developed and the SCE power review has started. This review can take 4 to 5 weeks. The total cost of the two Bob Wiley wells to date is \$903,710.18.

It is requested that the Board determine that the failure of three County wells located at the Bob Wiley Detention Facility and Mooney Grove Park originally taken to the Board of Supervisors on June 2, 2015 is a continuing emergency (4/5ths vote required).

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

This project is funded in the Capital Projects Fund. Savings from the monies that were allocated for the Porterville Justice Partners site will be utilized to cover the costs of these emergency well repairs. The total costs to date for all three wells is \$1,367,735.03

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five year Strategic Plan includes the Safety and Security initiative to provide for the safety and security of the public. Declaring the loss of the wells as an emergency aligns with the initiative by providing improved well facilities for the protection of the public.
