SUBJECT:

Amendment One to Measure R Program Supplement With Tulare County Transportation Authority For Betty Drive Interchange Project

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve Amendment One to the Measure R Program Supplement Agreement No. 26268 with the Tulare County Transportation Authority increasing the total amount by \$3,400,000 from \$6,666,000 to an amount not to exceed \$10,066,000 for right of way acquisition and utility relocation for the Betty Drive Interchange Project; and
- Authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign Amendment One to the Measure R Program Supplement after review and approval as to form by County Counsel.

SUMMARY:

The State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is undertaking a project to reconstruct the Betty Drive Interchange in the community of Goshen. The purpose of the project is to reduce traffic congestion and improve traffic flow at the interchange. The existing interchange will be completely replaced with a new interchange designed and constructed to meet current engineering standards to improve traffic operations on Betty Drive, as well as on the mainline of State Route 99 and the local streets in the interchange area.

This Amendment One to the Measure R Program Supplement is a companion agreement to the Cooperative Agreement between Caltrans and the County. The Tulare County Transportation Authority (Measure R) is providing funding to the

County to be used to reimburse Caltrans for the right of way acquisition and utility relocation phase of this project. This amendment will increase the amount of funding from Measure R by \$3,400,000 from \$6,666,000 to an amount not to exceed \$10,066,000.

The Tulare County Board of Supervisors approved the initial Measure R Program Supplement for the Betty Drive Interchange Project right of way acquisition and utility relocation phase at the board meeting on September 17, 2013 under County Agreement 26268. The construction phase of the project is proposed to be funded with Measure R funds and is expected to begin in late 2016 or early 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net County cost to the General Fund associated with the execution of this Amendment One to the agreement. Revenue in the form of Measure R funds in the amount of \$10,066,000 will be used to reimburse Caltrans for right of way acquisition and utility relocation and to cover County administrative costs.



Betty Drive Interchange Right of Way AMMENDMENT ONE

This Amendment One to Program Supplement executed under authority of Resolution 2013-0683 is made and entered into on, by and between the County of Tulare ("Sponsor") and the TULARE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS, acting as the Local Transportation Authority ("Authority").
WHEREAS the California Transportation Department (Caltrans) is undertaking a project to improve the State Route 99 and Betty Drive Interchange (PROJECT); and
WHEREAS Project is identified in the Measure R Expenditure Plan and is partially funded by Measure R; and
WHEREAS SPONSOR has entered into a Cooperative Agreement with State of California acting through Caltrans (Caltrans Agreement Number 06-1549) on 9/17/13 commonly referred to as Tulare County Agreement Number 26269; and
WHEREAS SPONSOR has modified the Cooperative Agreement with State of California acting through Caltrans (Caltrans Agreement Number 06-1549) per Amendment No. 1 on commonly referred to as Tulare County Agreement Number; and
WHEREAS SPONSOR desires to be reimbursed by AUTHORITY; and
WHEREAS AUTHORITY desires to reimburse SPONSOR; and
WHEREAS This Amendment One to Program Supplement hereby incorporates the "Measure R Cooperative Agreement" for Measure R Expenditures which was entered into between the SPONSOR and the AUTHORITY on May 22, 2007 (Tulare County Agreement No. 23149) and is subject to all terms and conditions thereof. This Amendment One to Program Supplement is executed under authority of Resolution No, approved by the SPONSOR on (See copy attached); and
WHEREAS this Amendment One to Program Supplement increases total amount from \$6,666,000 to \$10,066,000 in Measure R Regional Funds.
