**SUBJECT:** Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 26176 with the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Lake Kaweah Recreation Area.

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and approve an amendment to Agreement No. 26176 with the United States Army Corps of Engineers for law enforcement services at Lake Kaweah Recreation Area, in the amount of \$37,000, retroactive to April 22, 2016 through April 23, 2017. The amendment to the Agreement is retroactive because it was received from the United States Army Corps of Engineers after April 22, 2016.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed amendment to the Agreement as of April 22, 2016 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
3. Ratify the Chairman's signature on four copies of the amendment to the agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

This is the fourth year of a five-year agreement that was approved by your Board on July 31, 2012. The reimbursement amount covered by the amendment is for \$37,000 and is effective for the performance period of April 22, 2016 through April 23, 2017

The Sheriff's Department has provided law enforcement patrol services to the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Lake Kaweah Recreation Area, for many years. The

agreement includes one Deputy Sheriff and a patrol vehicle. Law enforcement service days shall be Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Federal holidays.

The primary duties of the Deputy Sheriff will include answering calls for service, routine patrol, response to emergency calls, and investigation of criminal offenses occurring in the Corps recreation, administration and wildlife management areas.

The original agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel and was approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 9, 2013. There were no substantive deviations from the County contract boilerplate included in the original agenda item. The proposed amendments to the agreement do not include any substantive deviations from the County contract boilerplate.

The only changes from the original agreement, as amended to date, are changing the time period of the agreement to April 22, 2016 through April 23, 2017, and changing the dollar amount under the agreement to \$37,000.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

Total revenue to be billed to the Corps of Engineers will not exceed \$37,000. Funds were included in the Sheriff Department's 2015/2016 budget and will be rolled-over to the 2016/2017 budget, as well. There is no net County cost.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute, and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. The amendment to the agreement will help fulfill this initiative by providing normal, emergency and unanticipated enforcement of civil and criminal laws of the State and County of Tulare jurisdiction on Corps of Engineers' land.
