**SUBJECT:** Approve amendment to Tulare County Agreement 26188

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 26188 with the Visalia Unified School District to extend the agreement to provide a School Resource Officer for Charter Alternatives Academy until June 2, 2017, and to increase the budget (Exhibit A-1) in the amount of \$83,210.
2. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the amendment.

**SUMMARY:**

The Sheriff's Department has provided a deputy to serve as the school resource officer (SRO) at Charter Alternatives Academy since 2007. The campus, located outside the city limits of Visalia in rural Tulare County, is administered by the Visalia Unified School District. The alternative school serves high school students who have not been successful in the district's regular high schools due to behavioral or other problems.

The SRO assists school officials maintain discipline on campus. The deputy regularly counsels students against gang membership, illegal drug usage, and other problem behaviors. When necessary, the deputy takes students into custody for criminal behavior.

The original agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel and approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 23, 2013. The substantive deviations from the standard County contract boilerplate included in the original agenda item were:

indemnification is mutual. The proposed amendments to the agreements do not include any additional substantive deviations from the standard County contract boilerplate. The only changes from the original agreement, as amended to date, are extending the agreement for another year through June 2, 2017, and the updating the budget (Exhibit A-1).

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The deputy's salary and benefits for the 2016-17 school year are estimated at \$79,660. An additional \$3,550 is allocated for the deputy's cell phone, radio, and motor-pool expenses. These items total \$83,210. Of this amount, the school district will pay \$65,999. The Sheriff's Department will use Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funding for the balance (\$17,211) of the officer's expenses. The program's revenues and expenditures are included in the Sheriff's Fiscal Year 2016-17 budget. There will be no net County cost to provide this officer to the school district

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The Safety and Security Initiative is one of four initiatives in the Tulare County Strategic Business Plan. The purpose of the initiative is to provide for safety and security of the general public. The FY 2016 JAG grant program will enhance public safety through the support of law enforcement efforts by the Sheriff's Department.
