SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with Victor Treatment Centers, Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$110,000 for the provision of intensive mental health services to Tulare County minors effective from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Mental Health Branch, contracts with Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., for Rate Classification Level (RCL) 13/14 Group Home Facilities. These facilities provide specialty mental health services to Tulare County children and adolescents. Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., provides specialty mental health treatment modalities including the following services: assessment, plan development, individual and group therapy, medication support, case management, and crisis intervention.

Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., are classified as RCL 13/14 group homes and therefore offer the highest level of care possible for Tulare County youth who are full-scope Medi-Cal beneficiaries or have been authorized by the Tulare County Resources Intensive Services Committee for admission. Additionally, all children and adolescents must be dependents of Tulare County Child Welfare Department or a ward of Tulare County Probation Department, and unable to be maintained in a lower level group home in California. Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., has facilities

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located in Stockton, Santa Rosa, and Redding, California. Through this agreement with Victor Treatment Centers, Inc., it is estimated that approximately 2-3 consumers will be served by this provider for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

This agreement did not include a Request For Proposal process because Victor Treatment Centers, Inc. is classified as a RCL 13/14 group homes that offers intensive residential services to our high needs child welfare services and probation youth. Tulare County has a very limited number of RCL 13/14 group homes to serve this population and have contracted with Victor Treatment Centers, Inc. for over fifteen years.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Funding for this agreement in an amount not to exceed \$110,000 will be included in the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 budget. These services are paid through Medi-Cal revenues. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation by providing intensive mental health services to Tulare County children and adolescents.
