**SUBJECT:** Approve an amendment to Tulare County Agreement 26444 with the Superior Court of California, County of Tulare.

**REQUEST(S):**  
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an amendment to Agreement 26444 between the Sheriff's Office and the Superior Court of California, County of Tulare to extend the agreement to June 30, 2019 for court security services.
2. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the amendment.

**SUMMARY:**  
On February 25, 2014, your Board approved an agreement with the Superior Court of California, County of Tulare to provide court security services at the Tulare County Court facilities for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015. Your board approved an amendment on June 30, 2015 to extend the term of the agreement to June 30, 2017. Today, the Sheriff's Office is requesting to amend the existing agreement to extend the term of the agreement an additional two years, to June 30, 2019.

On June 30, 2011, Governor Jerry Brown signed Assembly Bill 118 (AB 118) which requires each county to create a Local Revenue Fund 2011. Chapter 6.3, Section 30035(f)(3), requires the funds in the Trial Court Security Account be exclusively used to fund trial court security provided by county Sheriff's.

With the passing of AB 118, the funding that previously was allocated to the Tulare County Superior Court by the Administrative Office of the Courts, to pay for

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security service, has now been allocated directly to the Sheriff's Office.

The services consist of providing court security functions during normal court hours, traditional bailiff services for each judicial officer and identification of potential security threats from inmates or other persons. Court security staffing includes 52 Sheriff's deputies, 12 Sheriff's Security Officers, four Sergeants, and 90% of a Lieutenant position, for a total of 68.9 full-time equivalent positions.

The original agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel and was approved by the Board of Supervisors on February 25, 2014. The deviation from the County contract protocol identified in the original agenda item was that this is a two-year agreement. The proposed amendment to the agreement does not include any additional deviations from the County contract protocol. The only change from the original agreement is the term of the agreement, to extend through June 30, 2019.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The funding from the Trial Court Security Account is approximately \$5,792,177. The Department will also receive one time trial court security growth funding from the State; however, that amount is to be determined. There is no additional County cost related to this amendment to the Agreement.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to provide for the safety and security of the public. The amendment to the Agreement will help fulfill this initiative by providing screening services to detect weapons, explosives or any objects that can be used as weapons that can cause harm or threat to courthouse occupants and to safely secure the atmosphere conducive to a peaceful and efficient administration of justice.
