

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
Superior Court of California, Tulare County**

This **SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**, referred to as MOU, is entered into as of July 1, 2017, between the SHERIFF OF TULARE COUNTY, referred to as SHERIFF, and the SUPERIOR COURT OF CALIFORNIA, COUNTY OF TULARE, referred to as COURT, with reference to the following:

- A. The parties entered into Tulare County Agreement No. 26444, effective July 1, 2013, to provide court security;
- B. The parties entered into an amendment on June 30, 2015 to extend the term of the MOU for a period of two years, to June 30, 2017
- C. The parties now desire to extend said MOU for two additional years as provided below.

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS AGREED:**

- 1. Section 2 of the MOU is amended to read in its entirety as follows:
  - 1. **TERM:** This Memorandum of Understanding and Exhibits shall become effective July 1, 2017 and shall terminate on June 30, 2019, unless otherwise terminated as provided in the Memorandum of Understanding.

Except for the amended paragraphs of said MOU, all other terms and conditions of said MOU shall remain in full force and effect.
