SUBJECT: Terminate a Local Emergency due to Flooding, as ratified on June 27, 2017

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:
Proclaim the termination of a Local Emergency due to Flooding on the Kings River, as ratified on June 27, 2017 by Resolution No. 2017-0528

SUMMARY:
A local emergency was proclaimed on June 23, 2017, and subsequently ratified by the Board on June 27, 2017 at a special meeting, due to flooding on the Kings River (which began on or about June 18, 2017). During this incident, low-lying areas around the Kings River, including Riverland Resort & RV Park, Lindy's Landing, Club Royal Oak, and the Kings River Golf & Country Club were inundated due to significant flood control releases from Pine Flat Dam. River bank breaches occurred in the area of Kings River Golf & Country Club on June 23, 2017, requiring a significant commitment of local and State resources to mitigate in the following days. The estimated cost of the response to the County was slightly over \$400,000, and a request for California Disaster Assistance Act funding is pending with the Governor's Office of Emergency Services.

Given that the flooding incident and lingering impacts have been mitigated, and flows on the Kings River have returned to normal levels sufficient to warrant reopening of the river to recreational use, staff recommends terminating the local emergency at this time, as prescribed by California Government Code §8630(d). Termination of the local emergency after the end of the incident period does not impact the County's ability to recover costs via the California Disaster Assistance Act, should the State approve the funding request.

SUBJECT: Terminate a Local Emergency due to Flooding, as ratified on June 27, 2017

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FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no cost to terminating a local emergency proclamation. Termination of the local emergency does not impact the County's ability to receive California Disaster Assistance Act funding should it be authorized.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security element, with a goal to plan and provide coordinated emergency preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation capabilities for both natural and man-made disasters. The proclamation of a local emergency allows for the rapid implementation of critical response actions necessary to protect life and property should such response become necessary.
