

**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT  
PAAR CENTER**

**THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT** is entered into as of \_\_\_\_\_, 2017 between the COUNTY OF TULARE, referred to as COUNTY, and the PAAR, referred to as CONTRACTOR, with reference to the following:

- A. The COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into Agreement No. 25986, effective January 1, 2013, for the purpose of providing quality treatment, supervision, and case management services;
- B. Tulare County Agreement No. 25986 was subsequently amended by Tulare County Agreement No. 25986-A, 25986-B, 25986-C, 25986-D and 25986-E to extend the term of the agreement and revise the maximum dollar amount to be paid under the agreement;
- C. The COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree to amend Agreement No. 25986 to extend the term of the agreement to June 30, 2018.
- D. This amendment shall become effective July 1, 2017

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS AGREED:**

- A. Paragraph 1 of said Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 1. **TERM:** Agreement shall become effective as of January 01, 2013 and shall expire at 11:59 PM on June 30, 2018 unless otherwise terminated as provided in this Agreement.
- B. Except for herein amended paragraph, all other terms and conditions of Agreement No. 26288 and its subsequent amendments shall remain in full force and effect.
