SUBJECT:

Transfer of the Monson Community Well and Water System to the Sulfana Community Services District via Quitclaim Deed

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve a quitclaim deed for the transfer of ownership of the Monson Community Well and Water System to the Sultana Community Services District (4/5th vote required); and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign the quitclaim deed; and
- Authorize the Director of the Resource Management Agency or his/her designee to take the necessary actions under the agreement to complete the transfer.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County was the lead agency for a project to design and construct a new community based municipal well, a water distribution system, a filling station, and appurtenances in the community of Monson to alleviate issues with water supply and quality affecting the residents. The project was undertaken with the intent that the project would be operated by the Sultana Community Services District (SCSD), with residents entering into an Extraterritorial Service Agreement with the SCSD to this effect.

The County previously entered into an agreement with SCSD (Agreement No. 28359) which required approval by the Department of Water Resources and the State Water Resources Control Board, grant funders for the project, before the agreement was finalized. Now that the agreement has been finalized, the property transfer may take place subject to the provisions of Government Code §§ 6061 &

25365. These statutes require the County to publish notice at least one week prior to the transfer in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County. To this end, an advertisement was placed in the Visalia Times Delta last week, a copy of which is attached. Further, staff is requesting your Board approve an updated quitclaim deed to reflect the change in the year and in the Chairman since the previous quitclaim deed was approved.

Under the agreement, SCSD will be responsible for operating and maintaining the system, setting and collecting rates, and other tasks associated with managing a public water system. County will not be liable for any costs related to maintain, operating, or managing the system. The agreement also provides that the real property and appurtenances will be conveyed to SCSD via quitclaim deed. Further, the conveyance of the real property is subject to reverter and requires that the real property be used for a public water system. The agreement also included a draft quitclaim deed and required that the final quitclaim deed be in substantially similar form.

The land to be transferred includes the well site, which is approximately 0.89 acres and was purchased using grant funds, and a waterline construction and maintenance easement, which was also acquired using grant funds. Other real property and equipment to be transferred hereunder include the waterlines, well, tank, fill station, pumps and other equipment, and appurtenances thereto all of which were acquired using grant funds.

Your Board previously approved a Notice of Exemption for this project (Resolution 2017-0859), finding that the transfer of property was exempt from CEQA under the General Rule Exemption (14 Cal. Code Regs. Section 15061(b)(3)).

The project was constructed by Brough Construction, Inc. of Arroyo Grande, California and designed by Provost and Pritchard Consulting Group. The project was funded by three grants, \$500,000 from an Emergency Community Water Assistance (ECWAG) Grant from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), \$400,000 from the Department of Water Resources (DWR), and \$1,215,000 from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB). DWR and SWRCB will also be required to approve the transfer of this system. USDA staff have confirmed that USDA does not need to approve the transfer.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is No Net County Cost to the General Fund. The County will not be liable for the operations, maintenance, or management of the system after the transfer.

All real property and equipment to be transferred under this agreement were acquired using grant funds. Staff has worked with the grant funding agencies to seek approval of this transfer of property as necessary.

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LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes a Quality of Life initiative to provide an adequate and safe water supply. This transfer will allow the community of Monson to receive clean and safe water from the Sultana Community Services District.



MONSON WATER LINE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE EASEMENT APN 033-040-033





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
