REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Child Welfare Services Division with Abrazo Foster Family Agency to provide services on behalf of Tulare County Child Welfare Services' foster children through cooperation, collaboration, and sharing of appropriate information effective upon signature through June 30, 2019; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies each of the Memorandum of Understanding.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Child Welfare Services Division has mandates from statutory code that require placement of a child in a safe and caring foster home when a child is removed from their home due to abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation. Welfare and Institutions Code Section 16500 states, "The Legislation hereby declares its intent in providing for this statewide system of Child Welfare Services that all children are entitled to be safe and free from abuse and neglect." As part of this legislation, Child Welfare Services monitors all foster family agencies when a Tulare County foster child is placed in one of their foster homes for compliance with the delivery of services and placement regulations. Child Welfare Services meets quarterly with participating foster family agencies to ensure children are receiving quality services.

SUBJECT: Approve the Memorandum of Understanding with Abrazo Foster

Family Agency

DATE: March 20, 2018

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) does not require a competitive Request for Proposal, as any foster family agency may request to enter into the MOU. A foster family agency must agree to the conditions in the Memorandum of Understanding and complete the process for signature through the Tulare County HHSA to enter into the MOU.

The goal of the MOU is to provide a collaborative approach for the delivery of safe, secure, and compassionate homes that meet placement regulations and court ordered case plan services for foster children in Tulare County when removed from their home. Abrazo Foster Family Agency will provide placement for approximately 50 children through June 30, 2019.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following term deviates substantively from standard County boilerplate: This MOU has a term of multiple years commencing upon signature through June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no cost associated with this MOU. There is no additional cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that will support monitoring of a foster family agency foster home for Tulare County foster children. The MOU will encourage and support an innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk youth and children placed in a foster family agency foster home. The quality of life for these at-risk youth and children will be improved with the support of the MOU to be safe and free from abuse and neglect while placed in a foster family agency foster home.
