Ratify Attendance of County Employees and Use of County

Property at Charitable Fund Drive

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Find that the Silver Dollar Pancake Breakfast assisted in meeting the social needs of the population of Tulare County.
- 2. Ratify the attendance of County staff and use of County equipment at the Silver Dollar Pancake Breakfast to raise funds for the March for Babies.

SUMMARY:

The March of Dimes is a nonprofit charitable organization that funds research and provides resources to children who survive early births but who may suffer lifelong health problems such a cerebral palsy, vision and hearing loss, and intellectual disabilities. The March for Babies is an annual event to raise money for the important work conducted by the March of Dimes.

On March 16, 2018, some members of the Sheriff's and Fire Department and the District Attorney's Office participated in the Silver Dollar Pancake Breakfast at the Peace Officer Memorial to raise money for the March for Babies which took place at Mooney Grove Park on April 22, 2018. The ingredients for the pancake breakfast were donated by the Deputy Sheriff's Association, and the grill used to cook the pancakes belonged to the jail.

SUBJECT: Ratify Attendance of County Employees and Use of County Property at

Charitable Fund Drive

DATE: April 24, 2018

Pursuant to Government Code section 26227, the Board of Supervisors may authorize County officers and employees to carry out charitable fund drives conducted in cooperation with one or more nonprofit charitable organizations if the Board of Supervisors deems the program will assist in meeting the social needs, including the health, of the population of the County. The County officers and employees assisting with the charitable fund drive may also use County property to help carry out the program.

The Silver Dollar Pancake Breakfast raised funds to support the local March for Babies. As described above, the March for Babies raises awareness and funds that supports the health needs for babies who are born prematurely here in Tulare County and throughout the nation.
