**SUBJECT**: Approve a Waiver of the Bid Process for a Sole Source Purchase

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve a waiver of the bidding requirements under Ordinance Code Section 1-03-1305 for the purchase of a previously approved 7500 Fast DX Real Time PCR Instrument (Resolution 2017-0545) in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 under criteria for a sole source purchase.

#### SUMMARY:

On July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Tulare County Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of a 7500 Fast DX Real Time PCR instrument in the amount not to exceed \$70,000. The 7500 Fast DX is used in a variety of diagnostic procedures. The Public Health Laboratory currently uses a 7500 Fast DX instrument and the purchase of a second will significantly increase the laboratory's capacity to process samples. Research by the Public Health Laboratory staff has determined that the 7500 Fast DX Real Time PCR Instrument is made by a single manufacturer and sold only through their direct sales process. The Public Health Laboratory staff are already trained on operation of the 7500 Fast DX, and the device can be added to existing service and maintenance contracts that are required to keep it in proper calibration. Given these reasons, the laboratory is requesting that the Tulare County Board of Supervisors waive the bid process and approve the purchase of the 7500 Fast DX as a sole source purchase.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

All necessary fiscal approvals are already in place and properly accounted for in the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 budget. The funds come from a Zika Virus preparedness

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grant. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's strategic plan includes the Safety and Security element to plan and provide coordinated emergency preparedness response, recovery and mitigation capabilities for natural and manmade disasters. The Public Health Laboratory plays a critical role in a variety of public health emergency response activities, and steps taken to improve the lab's capacity speak directly to this element of Tulare County's strategic plan.
