SUBJECT:

Approve an agreement with Walgreen Co.

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve the 340B Contract Pharmacy Services agreement with Walgreen Co. retroactively from October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2020. This agreement is retroactive due to inadvertent delays in processing for approval. It was impracticable for the Board to take action prior to October 1, 2017 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item;
- 2. Find that the board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of October 1, 2017 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date; and
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

### SUMMARY:

The County has an obligation under the Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code Section 17000 to provide or arrange for medical care and pharmaceutical services via the 340B Drug Discount Program. The 340B Drug Discount Program is a federal program that allows participating drug manufacturers to provide discounted drug pricing to eligible healthcare organizations which serve the county's indigent and vulnerable population. Tulare County has a substantial number of individuals whose access to medical care is limited by the lack of transportation to medical services and/or the high cost of prescription medication. These limitations continue

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to be the primary causes for individuals not obtaining the necessary medical care.

HHSA contracts with several pharmaceutical chains which allows the County to meet the Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code Section 1700 obligation for pharmaceutical services via the 340B Drug Discount Program. Pharmacy services are a vitally important part of medical treatment as they contribute to the cure and prevention of disease, the improvement and maintenance of personal health and help prevent the worsening of existing conditions. The result is improved personal health, less trips to a medical facility and the postponement of the need for long term medical care. The net effect is reduced overall costs.

Walgreen Co. pharmacies has been providing pharmaceutical services to the County's indigent population through the federal 340B drug discount program. This agreement expired on September 30, 2017. Due to a miscommunication the agreement was not extended, yet clinic patients continued to make use of their services through the 340b drug discount program. The 340b discount program continued to benefit Tulare County residents by ensuring that discounted drug pricing was being made available. Tulare County did not incur costs during this expiration period. HHSA has implemented new protocols to prevent the need for future retroactive approval in the future.

HHSA is seeking board authorization to approve this retroactive agreement. Approval of the agreement with Walgreen Co. will ensure the continuation of the 340B program to eligible patients. This agreement will serve Tulare County's indigent clients and indirectly serve many of the over 8,000 clients who regularly seek services at the County's health care centers.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate from the standard County boiler plate: (1) The term of this agreement is multi-year; (2) Upon expiration of the initial three (3) year term, this agreement shall be renewed automatically for three (3) successive one-year terms, unless terminated earlier; and (3) This agreement includes mutual indemnification.

### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This agreement will have no fiscal impact on any HHSA programs, and continue to provide greater access, flexibility, convenience to the County's patients and the availability of discount drug pricing to County's indigent and vulnerable population. There is no County match requirement with this agreement and there is no additional net cost to the County general fund.

## **LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

This request furthers the Quality of Life Initiative which promotes public health and welfare. This agreement supports this initiative by continuing to provide access to specific Walgreen contract pharmacies and ensures an improved quality of life for indigent 340B eligible clients who have no other means of securing the necessary

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pharmacy related services.
