Adopt a resolution proclaiming the month of May 2018 as "Mental Health Awareness Month" in Tulare County

SUMMARY:

The goal of Mental Health Awareness Month is to raise awareness and educate the general public about mental illness stigma, mental health, and the possibility of wellness and recovery for those with mental illness.

A number of planned events will celebrate Mental Health Awareness Month in Tulare County. These events include: a mental health float in the Porterville Cinco de mayo parade; a mental health consumer picnic which is planned and implemented by consumers, family members, and volunteers; a Mini-Conference at Porterville College (May 2); an art show at the Arts Consortium depicting *Stories of Lived Experience*; and a Children's Art Show /Open House (hosted in Spanish, occurring at several of the Family Resource Centers throughout Tulare County). The Visalia Rawhide baseball organization will also celebrate Mental Health Awareness Month at their May 4th baseball game. The Visalia Rawhide has designed their home jersey to be turquoise, the color used by the Tulare County Mental Health Branch to symbolize mental health awareness.
