**SUBJECT:** Approve an Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Lake Kaweah Recreation Areas.

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to provide law enforcement services at Lake Kaweah Recreation Areas in the amount of \$38,000, retroactive to the performance period of April 27, 2018 through September 3, 2018. The Agreement is retroactive because there was a delay in receiving the agreement for processing from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of April 27, 2018 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
3. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the Agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

For many years the Tulare County Sheriff's Office has provided law enforcement patrol services to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Lake Kaweah Recreation Areas. Under this agreement one Deputy Sheriff and a patrol vehicle will be assigned to service the Lake Kaweah Recreation Sites located within Tulare County. Law enforcement service days shall be all Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal holidays falling within the performance period.

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The primary duties of the Deputy Sheriff will include answering calls for service, routine patrol, response to emergency calls, and investigation of criminal offenses occurring in the U.S. Army Corps Lake Kaweah recreation, administration, and wildlife management areas.

The Lake Kaweah Recreation Areas to be serviced under this agreement include:

- Lemon Hill Recreation Area
- Kaweah Recreation Area
- Horse Creek Campground
- Horse Creek Day Use Area
- Horse Creek Road Recreation Area
- Slick Rock Recreation Area
- Cobble Knoll Recreation Area
- Park Headquarters
- Terminus Dam and Tower
- Lake Kaweah Mitigation Areas and Stilling Ponds

The reimbursement amount covered by the Agreement is \$38,000 and is effective for the performance period of April 27, 2018 through September 3, 2018.

The Department would like to note that the United States Army Corps of Engineers has routinely used digital signatures in the last several years. The electronic signature on the Agreement is valid as an original signature.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

Total revenue to be billed to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will not exceed \$38,000. Funds were included in the Sheriff's 2017/2018 and 2018/2019 operating budget. There is no net County cost.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate, arrest, prosecute, and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. The agreement will help fulfill this initiative by allowing the Tulare County Sheriff's Office to provide normal emergency and unanticipated enforcement of civil and criminal laws of the State of California and of the County of Tulare on lands administered by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
