Approve an agreement with the California Department of Education

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with the California Department of Education to receive funding in an amount not to exceed \$6,100 for the Summer Food Service Program, effective from June 15, 2018 through September 14, 2018; and
- 2. Authorize the chairman of the Board to sign seven (7) copies of the agreement, Federal Certification, and the CCC-307 Contractor Certification Clauses.

SUMMARY:

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) is designed to supplement the National School Lunch Program. Meals are prepared by or purchased from a school or commercial vending company. The State provides reimbursement for organizations that prepare and serve meals during summer vacation and will reimburse Tulare County Environmental Health Services Division for conducting health and sanitation inspections of the food service facilities within Tulare County and in accordance with state and local environmental health standards. Inspectors will observe for safe and sanitary food handling techniques as well as proper storage of food, including leftovers. Equipment used in the transporting and delivery of meals will be tested for temperature and damage control. It is anticipated that seventy (70) or more sites will receive inspections from June 15, 2018 through September 14, 2018.

terms deviate substantively from the standard county boilerplate: 1) County must sign first; 2) County must indemnify the State; 3) State may terminate immediately with cause, and with 30 days' notice without cause, but the County can only request to terminate if State substantively fails to perform; 4) Dispute resolution decision of Superintendent of Public Instruction is final and binding.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The maximum amount of this agreement is \$6,100 and this will be received as revenue by the County and will be included in the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 proposed budget. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.
