SUBJECT:

Approve an agreement with Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc. for the provision of Co-Occurring Disorder Program in an amount not to exceed \$1,104,171 effective from July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Mental Health Branch, collaborates with Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc. (CVRS) to provide residential and outpatient substance abuse treatment through the Co-Occurring Disorder Program under the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Supports component to mental health consumers diagnosed with a co-occurring disorder.

Through the Co-Occurring Disorder Program, CVRS will work in coordination with Tulare County Mental Health providers utilizing the Hazelden Co-Occurring Disorder Program, an evidence-based model developed by Hazelden and Dartmouth Medical School. Services provided will be wellness, recovery, and resiliency focused; consumer centered; family focused; and delivered in a culturally and linguistically competent manner. From July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019, the program will provide services to 46 unduplicated consumers through residential services, and 248

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unduplicated consumers through the outpatient services.

The Tulare County Mental Health branch released a Request for Proposal (RFP) in April 2013 for the Co-Occurring Disorder program. The RFP review team reviewed the proposal and recommended the Mental Health Branch award the applicant, CVRS, the Co-Occurring Disorder Program contract. CVRS has been providing quality services to our mental health consumers since program inception.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Funding for this agreement in an amount not to exceed \$1,104,171 will be included in the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget. This agreement is paid through Medi-Cal and MHSA revenues. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote and encourage the provision of quality supportive services for individuals in Tulare County. The integrated treatment provided by the Co-Occurring Disorder Program will provide the wellness and recovery oriented services needed by many community members to live healthy and productive lives.
