**SUBJECT:**            Approval of an agreement with Woodlake Unified School District

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Woodlake Unified School District for the provision of a Differential Response Pre and Post Services program in the amount not to exceed \$101,000 effective from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 to serve in Visalia; and
  
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency Child Welfare Services, is requesting to contract with Woodlake Unified School District Family Resource Center (WUSD FRC) to provide Differential Response Pre and Post Services. The agreement provides community-based family support services for families referred to Child Welfare Services (CWS) or who have an open case with (CWS). Services are intended to promote safety and well-being of children and their families, increase strength and stability of families, increase parents' confidence in their parenting abilities, afford children a safe, stable, and supportive family environment, strengthen parental relationships, and otherwise enhance child development. Through this agreement, services will be provided to an estimated fifty (50) at-risk individuals and/or families.

In December 2014, Tulare County Board of Supervisors designated the Tulare County Child Protection Planning Council (CPPC) as the primary approval body for

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the Office of Child Abuse Prevention funding source: Promoting Safe and Stable Families. The CPPC and the Tulare County Child Abuse Prevention Council (CAPC) hold a Joint Allocations Committee (JAC) meeting to conduct a shared planning process of allocating Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention, and Treatment (CAPIT) funds, Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) funds, County Children's Trust (CTF) Funds, and Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) funds.

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Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) along with the CPPC and the CAPC developed a Request for Proposal (RFP) #17-043, Differential Response Pre and Post Services program. The RFP was released on January 4, 2017 and was reviewed by the Purchasing Department prior to its release. WUSD FRC submitted a proposal which was scored and reviewed in accordance with purchasing regulations. The CPPC and CAPC's Allocation Committee selected WUSD FRC to receive the award of CAPIT, CWS, and PSSF funding in the amount of \$101,000.

The Differential Response (DR) Pre and Post services program coincides with the Tulare County's 2017/2018-2021/2022 Integrated System Improvement Plan in compliance with the California Outcomes and Accountability System to improve outcomes for children. WUSD FRC provided DR Pre and Post services in the past five years known as DR and Family Transitional Supportive Services. These programs have been combined and renamed as DR Pre and Post Services Program. The fiscal year 2018-2019 will be the second year WUSD FRC provides DR Pre and Post Services to families.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The total amount of this agreement is \$101,000. This agreement is funded through the Child Abuse Prevention and Intervention Treatment; Child Welfare Services; and Promoting Safe and Stable Families Program funds which are flexible state and federal allocations for an array of services for families with children. These funds are included in the FY 2018/2019 budget. There is no net cost to the County General Fund.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. Differential Response case managers provide community resources to families to keep them from entering Child Welfare Services. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation.
