**SUBJECT**: Approve an Agreement with Turning Point of Central California

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an Agreement with Turning Point of Central California in the amount of \$350,000 per year, retroactive from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. The agreement is retroactive due to extenuating service provider circumstances and due to the date that the signed agreement was received.
- 2. Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of July 1, 2017, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign six (6) copies of the amendment.

#### **SUMMARY:**

Turning Point of Central California (Turning Point) operates five (5) community correctional programs in the Central Valley. Programs provided by the Turning Point Community Treatment Centers have operated for over 25 years and are designed to reduce the likelihood of return to crime or recidivism.

A major goal of the Turning Point Community Treatment Centers is to provide quality case management, treatment, supervision, and in-house services to adult offenders. The mission of the centers is to foster law-abiding behavior and self-sufficient living.

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The Visalia Re-entry Center of the Turning Point Community Centers enjoys strong ties to the local Employment Connection and to the Visalia Adult School and/or College of the Sequoias, which can help facilitate increased success inemployment and/or education for the clients served.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT / FINANCING:**

The anticipated cost for services during Fiscal Year 2017/2018 is \$350,000, which is included in the FY 2017/2018 approved budget. The costs associated with the agreement are offset by revenue received from SB 678 and AB 109 funding. There are no net County costs.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic business plan includes the Safety and Security initiative that provides for the safety and security of the public. The approval of this agreement helps fulfill this initiative by contracting with Turning Point of Central California for community-based services geared towards the rehabilitation of low-level offenders.
