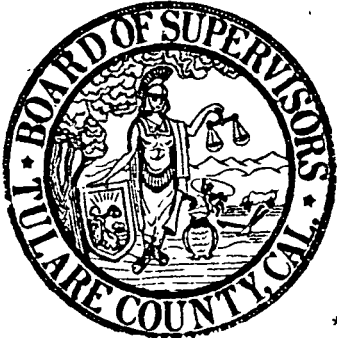

SUBJECT: Approve a Memorandum of Understanding

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the California Department of Insurance and the District Attorneys of Fresno, Tulare, Kings, Kern, Merced and Madera Counties, the Employment Development Department, and the Franchise Tax Board, effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021.
2. Authorize the District Attorney to sign three copies of the Memorandum of Understanding.

SUMMARY:

On June 20, 2017, your Board approved a Memorandum of Understanding (Agreement No. 28579) between California Department of Insurance and the District Attorneys of Fresno, Tulare, Kings, Kern, Merced and Madera Counties, the Employment Development Department, and the Franchise Tax Board. That MOU established a Workers' Compensation Fraud Task Force, allowing each agency to offer their respective program personnel to lend expertise and assist with Task Force cases, further reducing the impact of workers' compensation fraud and related criminal activity throughout the Valley.

The original MOU expires on June 30, 2018. This new MOU maintains the core components of the Task Force but includes a three year term of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021. There are no changes to our level of involvement in the

Task Force.

Funding for our Task Force involvement is already covered by our Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Program grant, and no new funding will be needed to participate.

The MOU requires the signatures of the District Attorneys in each participating county.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate:

1. Participating agencies are not required to indemnify the other participating agencies.
2. Participation may be terminated with 30 days prior written notice.
3. The Memorandum of Understanding may be signed in counterparts.
4. The parties agree to approve any amendment to the MOU voted on by the Task Force participants.
5. The term of the MOU is for three years.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

Any costs associated with our participation in this MOU will be covered by our Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Program grant. There is no Net County Cost.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year Strategic Business Plan and Management System include Safety and Security initiatives to provide for the safety and security of the public. Participation in this MOU helps to fulfill this initiative by continuing to provide staff to investigate and prosecute workers' compensation insurance fraud cases throughout the Central Valley, protecting businesses and individuals from being victims of this kind of fraud.
