

SUBJECT: Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 27349 with the City of Lindsay.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 27349 with the City of Lindsay to receive reimbursement for 50% of all costs of one-fifth (1/5) of a full time Probation Officer for the Non-Custody Intake Program, an estimated amount of \$8,053, to extend the term of the Agreement to June 30, 2019.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign four (4) copies of the amendment to Agreement No. 27349.

SUMMARY:

In December of 1993, the Board authorized the Chief Probation Officer to negotiate with other law enforcement agencies within Tulare County to enter into a partnership to share the funding of the Non-Custody Intake Program. Under this program, a Probation Officer has been deployed to the Lindsay Police Department to provide intake, diversion and supervision services to minors referred by that department. This program is partially funded by the City of Lindsay.

The original Agreement No. 27349 with the City of Lindsay, to receive reimbursement for 50% of all costs of one-fifth (1/5) of a full time Probation Officer for the Non-Custody Intake Program, was approved as to form by County Counsel on July 8, 2015 and approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 15, 2015. This amendment will allow the County to continue providing the Non-Custody Intake Program with the City of Lindsay.

SUBJECT: Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 27349 with the City of Lindsay.

DATE: June 12, 2018

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no General Fund expense involved with this program. The cost of the program for one (1) Probation Officer II is estimated at \$80,534. Reimbursement from the City of Lindsay is \$8,040. A number of the services provided in the program are eligible for reimbursement from Sales Tax Realignment for an estimated total of \$72,481. The position and the revenue will be included in the Tulare County Probation Department's Fiscal Year 2018-19 proposed budget.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic business plan includes provision for the safety and security of the public through collaboration with school districts, cities, and community-based non-profit organizations to promote early intervention for youth involved in gang activities and other criminal acts. The approval of this Agreement Amendment enables the Probation Officer to continue monitoring the youth in the city. One of the program goals is to provide targeted intervention services to divert youth from further incursion into the juvenile justice system, thus promoting safer communities.
