SUBJECT:

Approve payment for an extended warranty agreement with L3 Technologies Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve payment for a four year extended warranty agreement with L3 Technologies Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$48,000 for the period of July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2022.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the extended warranty agreement.

SUMMARY:

On February 14, 2017, your Board approved the purchase of two driving simulators with a one-year maintenance agreement from L3 Technologies Inc., which have been delivered and placed into use at the Sheriff's Office. The driving simulator provides instruction using state-of-the-art driving simulations in realistic scenarios depicting emergency operations, basic patrol stops, transportation of inmates, and high speed pursuit driving. Use of the simulators will allow Deputies to practice their judgment and critical decision-making skills for routine patrol, jail transport and emergency response situations. Additionally, the simulators will reduce potential liability exposure.

The Sheriff's Office is requesting you approve the purchase of an extended warranty agreement for four years. The L3 Technologies Inc. warranty agreement provides vital maintenance and repair services for software and hardware along with

scenario, vehicle, and location updates as they become available. These services and updates will ensure our equipment will function long into the future and provide effective training to our staff.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate 1) Agreement includes a multi-year term; 2) Agreement requires advanced payment; 3) Agreement includes a mutual indemnification; 4) County may not terminate the agreement unless contractor cannot repair or replace equipment.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

One year warranty service is \$5,500 per simulator, TCSO's two simulators will cost \$11,000 per year for a total of \$44,000 plus tax. The one-time payment to renew the L3 Technologies Inc. warranty agreement is not to exceed a total of \$48,000 for four years of service and will come from the Sheriff's Office FY 18/19 operating budget. There is no net County cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The Safety and Security Initiative is one of the initiatives in the Tulare County Strategic Business Plan. The purpose of the initiative is to provide for the safety and security of the public. This maintenance agreement is in line with this initiative.
