

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the Tulare County Sheriff's Office and the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways to provide financial reimbursement for Sheriff's Office training conducted for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the Memorandum of Understanding.

SUMMARY:

On July 21, 2015, the Tulare County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) assumed supervision of law enforcement marine patrol responsibility for Lake Kaweah and Lake Success. The transfer was in keeping with the typical practice of California counties to bring patrol of all public waterways under law enforcement. TCSO also provides law enforcement services on the Kings, Kern, and Kaweah Rivers.

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to allow TCSO to apply to the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways (Parks) for financial reimbursement only, for training authorized and approved by Parks. TCSO currently receives partial training reimbursement from another State source. This MOU would allow our agency to apply for reimbursement from Parks for those boating related training funds not already reimbursed from another State source. On June 20, 2017, your Board approved a similar MOU for the current FY 17/18,

SUBJECT: Approve an MOU with the California State Parks.

DATE: June 12, 2018 REVISED

Resolution No. 2017-0474 and Agreement No. 28172.

The MOU substantively deviates from the standard County boilerplate in that the County will be signing first.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

TCSO may be reimbursed for the allowed transportation, lodging, and subsistence expense incurred while attending and satisfactorily completing training courses approved by Parks. With the approval of this MOU there is no additional net County cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The Tulare County Strategic Business Plan includes a Security and Safety initiative. This MOU will allow our agency to request funding to continue to train our personnel to effectively respond to incidents to help those in need.
