

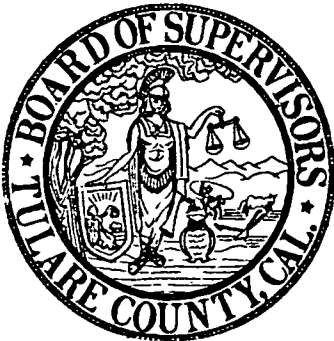

SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for Certified Farmer's Market Inspections

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture in the amount up to \$10,464 for Certified Farmers Market Inspections from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement

SUMMARY:

This agreement is intended to subvent costs incurred by the County for conducting inspections of Certified Farmers Markets and Certified Producers in coordination with the California Department of Food and Agriculture and other California counties. The inspections will verify what is being sold by a Certified Producer at a Certified Farmer's Market with what is being produced by the certified producer and what is listed on their Certified Producer's Certificate. Most investigations that are conducted by Tulare County are initiated by the counties where the most of the markets are located such as the San Francisco and Los Angeles areas. The Tulare County Agricultural Commissioner's Office is notified of the inspecting counties suspicions and we investigate accordingly helping to either prove or disprove those suspicions.

The agreement has been approved to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate:

SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for Certified Farmer's Market Inspections

DATE: June 26, 2018

1. Neither party to the agreement will indemnify the other.


FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There will be no additional net county cost in performing this service. The County will receive up to \$10,464 for FY 18/19 if this agreement is approved.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Tulare County's five year strategic plan includes the Economic Well Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. Approval of this Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture would help protect the county's agriculture-based economy. The inspections would help ensure that certified producers are growing the commodities they list on their certified producer's certificate.
