SUMMARY:

This Agreement is intended to subvent costs incurred by the County for inspections and sampling relating to the advertising and labeling of petroleum and automotive products at establishments selling or distributing petroleum and/or automotive products. This Agreement will allow for the continuation of this long-standing program during fiscal year 2018/2019.

The agreement has been approved to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate:

Neither party to the agreement will indemnify the other.

There will be no additional net county cost in performing this service. The County will receive up to \$12,075 for FY 18/19 if this Agreement is approved.
