SUMMARY:

The Sheriff's Office is requesting payment to vendors for services rendered by the vendors to the Sheriff's Farm operation. The Farm has two mission's, the first is to provide food items for our Detentions Division using multiple programs, such as beef, swine, poultry, fruits, and vegetables. The second, providing valuable rehabilitation and therapy through working with and caring for plants and animals directed at changing the criminal behavior of offenders, to become better citizens. The Sheriff's Farm Operation is one of only a few operated by correctional facilities in the U.S.

The Farm provides various food items such as meat, fruit, and vegetable's to feed the County's inmates, offsetting the County's food costs. The Sheriff's Farm is located at the Day Reporting Center (DRC). The Farm consists of 420 acres of irrigatable land, currently divided into 320 acres of Hay with 100 acres to be planted. Adjacent to this property is 630 acres of land set aside for grazing cattle with an additional 85 acres near Kingsburg River used for grazing yearlings, allowing for an increase in cattle operations and cost savings.

The Farm has many inmate programs such as the Beef Program (cow/calf), Swine Program and new Poultry Program, as well as a large garden for fruit and vegetable

production. In a partnership with Animal Control, the Sheriff's Farm has built a corral to house large animals such as horses, until adopted. The inmates learn how to care for these large animals, as well as the occasional goats, peacocks, ostriches, and turkeys. Inmates are trained on tractor operations to disc, furrow, and for harvest / planting, along with care of the food supply, as well as gleaning. The Farm operation programs provide the inmates with real life training in real time, using teamwork, understanding the importance of being punctual, and being reliable to others, while living animals, are relying on them. They are be able to leave incarceration and enter the farming workforce with a foundation on how a farm operates and the hard work and dedication needed to be successful members of society.

Operating the Sheriff's Farm entails using outside vendors to support some of the dangerous, unique, or specialized work needed that the Sheriff's staff or inmates are not able to complete, or have equipment available for use. In farming, the seasons and weather often play an important role in when certain processes are completed to ensure fields are serviced and animals are effectively used. With Tulare County being one of the top producers of food items such as crop and livestock in the nation, with a 2016 gross production value of almost \$6.4 billion and 1,745,516 harvested acres, many farms are competing with each other for vendor support.

The Sheriff's Office does not have a Public Works Agreement (PWA) or Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with the above listed vendors; they were all contacted as the immediate need had arisen. A farmer will never know if the vendor they have a contract with is available when needed due to weather change or other uncontrollable issue, due to the needs of other farmers having a similar need of similar vendors. Farming is an expensive operation and to have specialized equipment and trained personnel on staff to complete certain operations that are only necessary on an as needed basis would not be feasible for the Sheriff's Office.

The services were immediate needs of the Sheriff's Farm operations and were approved by the Sheriff's Office Farm manager when ordered. The Invoice No. 2978 of \$6,102.50 and Invoice No. 3550 of \$4,235 were paid using a County credit card but were eventually declined. As a result, overdue balance fee's were incurred when the invoices were not paid on time. Many of the invoices are months old.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The cost for the payments for the services and supplies in the amount of \$35,655.29 are budgeted in the Sheriff's Office FY 17/18 operating budget. There is no additional net County cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Organizational Performance Initiative to provide infrastructure to support better service delivery. The services used were consistent with this initiative.
