Exhibit A - The scope of work shall remain the same.

Exhibit B - The total budget shall remain \$150,000.00. The budget allocation by task shall be revised as shown in Exhibit B. Task 1 shall be increased by \$11,918.00 from \$135,000.00 to \$146,918.00 and Task 2 shall be reduced by \$11,918.00 from \$15,000.00 to \$3,082.00.

Exhibit C -The end date for the project shall remain June 30, 2018.

Reason for Change:

This Agreement covers coordination and maintenance of Household Tank program and shared databases as well as notary services in communities affected by the drought in Tulare County. This amendment will allow the County to be able to better allocate the funding by task.
