

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

#### **SUMMARY:**

Community Services and Employment Training, Inc. (CSET) works to change the environmental factors which influence youth in order to decrease alcohol and marijuana use by implementing evidence-based curriculum, alternative activities, and proven effective parent education, in a culturally competent manner.

Through this agreement CSET will target youth and parents living in or near the communities of Farmersville, Porterville, Orosi, Tulare, London, and north/central Visalia. It is estimated that approximately 200 consumers will receive services through this agreement in Fiscal Year 2018/2019.

This agreement did not include a Request for Proposal (RFP) process because CSET has been a long-standing contractor for alcohol and substance abuse prevention.

### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Funding for this agreement in the amount not to exceed \$103,201 will be included in the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 budget. This agreement is paid through the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation through parent and youth education to reduce underage drinking.
