SUMMARY:

The City of Woodlake operates a full time Woodlake Police Department (WPD) and Woodlake Fire Department (WFD) to provide law enforcement services and fire response services within the City of Woodlake. However, the City of Woodlake does not operate or have a dispatch center for WPD patrol officers or WFD personnel. The Tulare County Sheriff's Office (Sheriff's Office) has been providing call center and emergency dispatch services for WPD and WFD for several years by receiving calls for service from within the City of Woodlake and dispatching the calls to the appropriate City of Woodlake department. This agreement would allow the Sheriff's

department to continue to provide those services.

This agreement also allows WPD to access the Sheriff's Office password protected Application Data System (ADSI) for records and report writing applications. Access to ADSI shall be limited to law enforcement personnel, including WPD clerks and aides, as required. ADSI allows law enforcement agencies to share valuable data to aid in investigations while also allowing WPD to have a standardized report-writing platform for crime report submission to the District Attorney's Office.

A previous dispatch service agreement between the City of Woodlake and the Sheriff's Office was approved by your Board (Agreement No. 25741). This collaboration has worked well and both the Sheriff's Office and the City of Woodlake wish to continue this service.

The substantive deviations from the standard County boilerplate identified are: 1) the agreement provides for mutual indemnification, and 2) the agreement allows for termination without cause with 30 days prior notice for both parties.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Sheriff's Office based cost for service on the analysis of calls for services from the City of Woodlake that occurred over a period of time. The agreement amount of \$60,356 will be included in the Sheriff's FY 2018/19 budget. There is no net County cost.

### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The agreement aligns with the County's Safety and Security initiative by providing dispatch services to the City of Woodlake that the city is otherwise not able to provide.
