### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement Bakersfield Behavioral Healthcare Hospital, LLC retroactive from July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$900,000 (\$300,000 per Fiscal Year), for the provision of short-term, inpatient psychiatric services. This agreement is retroactive due to extended negotiations and the date it was received from the vendor making it impracticable for the Board to take action prior to July 1, 2017;
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2017, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date; and
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign three (3) copies of the agreement.

#### **SUMMARY:**

Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency (HHSA), Mental Health Branch, proposes to contract with Bakersfield Behavioral Healthcare Hospital, LLC (BBHH) in Bakersfield, California for the provision of 24-hour short-term medically necessary acute psychiatric inpatient care to Tulare County residents as described in Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations.

**SUBJECT**: Approve an agreement with Bakersfield Behavioral Healthcare Hospital,

**DATE:** July 31, 2018

It is estimated that sixty (60) consumers will benefit from the services of BBHH each fiscal year through this agreement. This agreement did not go out as a Request for Proposal because per W&I Code § 5600, counties are mandated to pay for acute psychiatric inpatient hospital services provided in Institutions for Mental Diseases (IMD) for Medi-Cal beneficiaries under the age of 21 or over 65 years. This agreement services this mandate by providing a fixed bundled rate for Tulare County consumers who receive mandated services at BBHH.

The agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following term deviates substantively from the standard County boilerplate: 1) it is a multi-year agreement.

## **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

This agreement has a budgeted amount of \$900,000 for the three (3) year agreement period with \$300,000 budgeted in each fiscal year. This agreement is funded with Realignment revenue. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

# LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation by providing access to 24-hour short-term medically necessary acute psychiatric inpatient care.
