REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement with the Tulare Joint Union High School District in the amount of \$88,155, to provide School Resource Officer services on district campuses for the period of August 9, 2018 through June 6, 2019.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare Joint Union High School District is seeking to continue to partner with the Sheriff's Office to provide a Sheriff's deputy to serve as a school resource officer on district campuses.

Under the agreement, the deputy provides a visible law enforcement presence on campus; assists school officials in enforcing school laws; utilizes intervention and prevention skills with students who are involved in criminal activity; acts as a resource deputy for school personnel; and provides classroom instruction on law enforcement issues such as gang awareness.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate: 1. Mutual indemnification.

SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with the Tulare Joint Union High School District.

DATE: July 31, 2018

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Sheriff's Office will be compensated \$88,155 by the Tulare Joint Union High School District for the salary, benefits, and operating costs for the school resource officer. Funds are included in the Sheriff's Fiscal Year 2018/2019 budget. There is no net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's strategic plan includes the Safety and Security initiative. This agreement supports this initiative by collaborating with the school district to provide a visible deterrent at schools while having an immediate response if necessary.
