- REQUEST(S):**
- That the Board of Supervisors:
1. Approve amendment #4 to Agreement No. 26738 with Los Angeles County to adjust Los Angeles County's rates for Fiscal Year 2018/19 for providing intrastate prisoner transportation services to Tulare County. The agreement is retroactive to July 1, 2018 because it was just received from Los Angeles County.
 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the amendment as of July 1, 2018, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four copies of the amendment to the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Sheriff's Office is responsible for the transportation of inmates from the location where they are in custody to the Tulare County jail system. Individuals are frequently detained in jurisdictions throughout the State of California on the authority of warrants issued from the County of Tulare.

The County of Los Angeles operates a statewide prisoner transportation bus system with scheduled weekly trips throughout the State of California. Utilizing this statewide transportation bus system, the Sheriff's Office no longer has to provide

these services, reducing costs for vehicle and fuel charges; overtime for two transportation deputies; and meals for the deputies. The contracted transportation service is a cost-effective option that is utilized whenever possible. Service is coordinated through the Sheriff's Office transportation unit. This type of agreement is authorized by Government Code Sections 26775 and 26776.

Agreement No. 26738 was approved on August 26, 2014, effective July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019. The amendments are necessary to adjust the rates, which are determined by Los Angeles County annually based on costs to provide the transportation services. A prior amendment, identical except for the term, hourly rate, and cost per mile was approved as to form by County Counsel on August 8, 2017. The substantive deviation from the standard County boilerplate in the prior agenda item was that the County signed first. The proposed renewal amendment does not include any deviations from the standard County boilerplate because the County of Los Angeles has signed first. The only changes from the prior amendment are to the new effective date of the rates exhibit for July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019; the new hourly rate of \$79.21 from \$73.10 for any significant deputy sheriff's time spent by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department transportation personnel booking or picking up County of Tulare prisoners; and the cost per prisoner, per mile of \$0.91 from \$0.92.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Costs associated with this agreement include \$0.91 per prisoner, per mile and \$8.00 for the cost of inmate meals. Additionally, an extra hourly rate of \$79.21 will be charged for any time extended during booking or picking up of inmates.

For FY 2017/18, \$4,543 was paid to LA County for transportation of 27 inmates and that amount was budgeted into the Sheriff's FY 2017/18 operating budget.

The amount is subject to vary based on the number of inmates transported by LA County each year. The Sheriff's Office estimates approximately \$5,000 will be paid to LA County for FY 2018/19 based on the number of times the service was utilized in FY 2017/18, or in previous years. The appropriation for this agreement is included in the Sheriff's FY 2018/19 operating budget and will be included in future operating budgets throughout the term of this agreement.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. This agreement will support the initiative by providing safe and secure ground service in returning felons under warrant to the custody of the Tulare County Sheriff's Office.
