#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a two year agreement between the Tulare County Sheriff's Office and College of the Sequoias in an amount not to exceed \$13,640, to provide emergency dispatch services retroactive from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020. The agreement is retroactive due to delays in negotiations.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2018, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the Agreement.

#### SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) has been providing emergency dispatch services to College of the Sequoias (COS) for several years through Agreement No. 25964. COS is requesting that TCSO continue to provide emergency dispatch services and enter into a new two year agreement for TCSO to provide the COS District Police with dispatch services twenty-four hours per day/seven days per week. TCSO emergency dispatchers will answer, monitor and respond to all emergency calls for the COS District Police to aid in the safety and security of staff, visitors and students. Dispatchers will alert appropriate personnel and also dispatch any additional personnel and/or equipment when necessary. It is estimated that

**DATE:** August 14, 2018

TCSO will dispatch approximately 700 calls for service for the COS District Police during this contract period.

The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate: 1) the agreement provides for mutual indemnification, and 2) the agreement is a multi-year agreement.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net County cost. The Sheriff's Office based cost for services on an analysis of dispatched calls for College of the Sequoias in the last four years.

The total agreement amount is \$13,640 with an annual agreement amount of \$6,820 for each year. Funds will be received on an annual basis for the term of the agreement. For the first year, \$6,280 have been included in the Sheriff's FY 2018/2019 operating budget. An additional \$6,280 will be included in the Sheriff's operating budget for FY 2019/2020.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The dispatch agreement with College of the Sequoias aligns with the Strategic Business Plan initiative of providing for safety and security of the public by providing emergency dispatch services to all three College of the Sequoia campus locations.
