SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with the Earlimart School District.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement with the Earlimart School District in an amount not to exceed \$88,280, for the Sheriff's Office to provide School Resource Officer services on district campuses, retroactive from August 8, 2018 to May 31, 2019. This agreement is retroactive due to delays in getting the agreement documents approved.
- Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of August 8, 2018, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Earlimart School District is seeking to continue to partner with the Sheriff's Office to provide a Sheriff's deputy to serve as a school resource officer (SRO) on district campuses. In a previous agreement with the school district a part time SRO was assigned to the school district. The Sheriff's Office will be providing one Full Time Employee (FTE) SRO due to the school district requesting an FTE SRO during the current school year.

Under the agreement, the deputy provides a visible law enforcement presence on campuses; assists school officials in enforcing school laws; utilizes intervention and

prevention skills with students who are involved in criminal activity; acts as a resource deputy for school personnel; and provides classroom instruction on law enforcement issues such as gang awareness.

A prior agreement, identical except for the term or time period and dollar value, was approved as to form by County Counsel and approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 29, 2017, Agreement No. 29290. The substantive deviations from the standard County boilerplate identified in the prior agenda item were: 1) Indemnification is mutual; 2) Either party may terminate without cause with 30 days' written notice. The proposed renewal agreement does not include any additional deviations from the standard County boilerplate. The only changes from the prior agreement are the time period of the agreement and the dollar amount of the agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Sheriff's Office will be compensated up to \$88,280 by the Earlimart School District for the salary, benefits, and operating costs for the school resource officer. Funds are included in the Sheriff's Fiscal Year 2018/2019 budget. There is no net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's strategic plan includes the Safety and Security initiative. This agreement supports this initiative by collaborating with the school district to provide a visible deterrent at schools while having an immediate response if necessary.
