Appointment to the Eastern Tule Groundwater Sustainability SUBJECT:

Agency's Executive Committee

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Appoint Denise England to the Eastern Tule Groundwater Sustainability Agency's Executive Committee

SUMMARY:

On December 6, 2016 your Board approved Agreement No. 27912 to form a Joint Powers Authority with other eligible public agencies in the Tule Sub-basin for the purposes of electing to become a Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA).

Over the past two years the JPA has elected to become a GSA and is now the exclusive GSA for a large portion of the Tule Sub-basin. The GSA has become more formalized by adopting by-laws, establishing standing committees, and recently hiring an Executive Director. These activities included the formal establishment of the Executive Committee.

The Eastern Tule GSA's Executive Committee is comprised of staff from member agencies and initially functioned in lieu of an Executive Director. Now that an Executive Director has been hired the Executive Committee functions as advisor to the Executive Director and sets the agenda for the GSA's Board of Directors. Denise England, Water Resources Director, has served on the Executive Committee since its inception. Due to the formalization of the GSA, a resolution appointing a staff member to the Executive Committee is required.
