REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve a resolution supporting Proposition 3 Water Supply and Water Quality Act of 2018

SUMMARY:

Proposition 3 Water Supply and Water Quality Act of 2018 is a citizen-led measure that will appear on the November 2018 ballot. The November Water Bond is sponsored by a wide variety of conservation, agricultural, water, and environmental justice organizations. The proponent of the November Water Bond is Dr. Gerald H. Meral. The Bond includes significant funding to address DAC drinking water and wastewater challenges, implement the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act, and fix the Friant-Kern Canal in Tulare County,

On August 13, 2018 the Tulare County Water Commission considered the provisions of Proposition 3 and recommended that the Board adopt a resolution in support.
