Requested Closure of Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency, Animal Services Division

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve the annual closure of Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency, Animal Services Division to the public on the Saturday following Thanksgiving; and
- 2. Direct staff to annually post notices on this closure at the shelter and on the Animal Services website.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Animal Services division's normal operating hours on Saturdays are 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. It is requested that Animal Services offices be closed annually to the public on the Saturday following Thanksgiving. This day is significant because it is the Saturday following the Thursday and Friday Thanksgiving holiday break observed by the County. Animal Services responds to approximately 17 calls on a typical working day, compared to an average of 5 calls on the Saturday after Thanksgiving.

Due to the reduced workload anticipated on this Saturday, it would be more efficient and cost effective to allow staff time off. Tulare County Animal Services Division would continue its usual Field Operations practice by providing 24-hour on-call services, and remain available to respond to emergencies. It is therefore requested that the office be

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closed on the specified day.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Organizational Performance initiative to continuously improve organizational effectiveness. Closing the shelter on a low demand day and reducing the number of pets in care, increases operational efficiency.
