PROGRAM NARRATIVE

The EDD/WSD awarded to the Tulare WDB \$1,146,829 to serve 1,383 workers dislocated as a result of the closure of five large employers: Tulare Regional Medical Center, Nypro, L.E. Cooke Company, TreeHouse, and ORS NASCO. A total of 429 participants will receive intensive services and 124 will receive education or training. This modification incorporates the \$1,146,829 of 25% Additional Assistance funding for the Tulare AA Grant Project in grant code 1132 with term dates of June 1, 2018 through November 30, 2019.
