Amend ordinance code to add alternative transportation cost as an eligible reimbursement for Tulare County Grand Jurors

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

SUMMARY:

Currently, the Code of Ordinances for the County of Tulare contains a provision regarding Mileage and Per Diem of Grand Jurors. The ordinance defines mileage traveled by members of the Tulare County Grand Jury while carrying out their duties as an eligible for reimbursement. However, there are no provisions in the Code for the transportation cost -- alternative mobile transportation used by any Grand Juror

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other than driving an automobile.

The following five counties; Kings, Kern, Fresno, Madera and Merced were surveyed for "Alternative Means of Transportation" as applied to reimbursement for Grand Jury members. It was found there is not a reference for such a policy in those five counties. The analysis included review of ordinance codes, county policies, employee policies, personnel rules and adopted budget.

As stated in the proposed ordinance amendment, "The Chief Administrative Officer, or designee, shall adopt a policy setting forth reimbursement rates for the Grand Jury for all other transportations costs". The County Administrative Office with assistance from the Auditor-Controller Office developed an Alternative Means of Transportation Policy specific to Grand Jurors. Refer to Attachment B. Essentially, the policy conforms to the IRS regulations for reimbursement of alternative means of transportation.

The ordinance's primary function is to amend section 1 of the Code, which would add alternative transportation cost incurred by members of the Tulare County Grand Jury to be eligible for reimbursement.

The proposed ordinance will elaborate the provisions of section 1 (a) and add section 1 (b) concerning transportation cost. The amendments are summarized as follows:

a. Mileage and Per Diem

- The County shall reimburse the members of the Tulare County Grand Jury for either the mileage or the transportation costs actually and necessarily traveled or incurred by them within the County of Tulare while carrying out their duties;
- A Grand Juror shall not be eligible to receive reimbursement for transportation costs in any month the Grand Juror has requested and received reimbursement for mileage;
- Reimbursement for mileage shall be at the current County rate and made consistent with County policies for mileage reimbursement;
- The Chief Administrative Officer, or designee, shall adopt a policy setting forth reimbursement rates for the Grand Jury for all other transportations costs as defined in this section. Any changes to said policy shall be provided to the Presiding Judge no later than 30 days prior to the effective date of such change.

b. Transportation Costs

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-19-1205 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF TULARE COUNTY, PERTAINING TO MILEAGE AND PER DIEM OF GRAND JURORS.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF TULARE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

- (a) The County shall reimburse the members of the Tulare County Grand Jury for either the mileage or the transportation costs actually and necessarily traveled or incurred by them within the County of Tulare while carrying out their duties, and outside the County of Tulare for the limited purpose of attending training authorized by the Superior Court in compliance with Penal Code Section 914(b) on any date after July 1, 1999. A Grand Juror shall not be eligible to receive reimbursement for transportation costs in any month the Grand Juror has requested and received reimbursement for mileage. Reimbursement for mileage shall be at the current County rate and made consistent with County policies for mileage reimbursement. The County Administrative Officer, or designee, shall adopt a policy setting forth reimbursement rates for the Grand Jury for all other transportations costs as defined in this section. Any changes to said policy shall be provided to the Presiding Judge no later than 30 days prior to the effective date of such change.
- (b) For the purposes of this section, "transportation costs" are the costs of alternative mobile transportation used by any Grand Juror other than driving an automobile. Alternative mobile transportation methods include, but are not limited to, the use of a bicycle, public transportation, taxi, or ride share service.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-19-1205 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF TULARE COUNTY, PERTAINING TO MILEAGE AND PER DIEM OF GRAND JURORS.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF TULARE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

- (a) The County shall reimburse the members of the Tulare County-Grand-Jury-for either the mileage or the transportation costs actually and necessarily traveled or incurred by them within the County of Tulare while carrying out their duties, and outside the County of Tulare for the limited purpose of attending training authorized by the Superior Court in compliance with Penal Code Section-914(914(b)) on any date after July 1, 1999. A Grand Juror shall not be eligible to receive reimbursement for transportation costs in any month the Grand Juror has requested and received reimbursement for mileage. Reimbursement for mileage shall be at the current County rate—and made consistent with County policies for mileage reimbursement. The County Administrative Officer, or designee, shall adopt a policy setting forth reimbursement rates for the Grand Jury for all other transportations costs as defined in this section. Any changes to said policy shall be provided to the Presiding Judge no later than 30 days prior to the effective date of such change.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-19-1205 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF TULARE COUNTY, PERTAINING TO MILEAGE AND PER DIEM OF GRAND JURORS.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF TULARE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

The ordinance will amend Ordinance Code Section 1-19-1025 provisions to expand grand jurors' ability to be reimbursed for travel costs actually and necessarily incurred for the purposes of carrying out their duties as grand jurors. It provides that when travel for the purposes of carrying out official grand juror duties, grand jurors may receive mileage reimbursements for the use of their own vehicle. In addition, grand jurors may receive reimbursements for alternative transportation costs, which include the use of a bicycle, public transportation, taxi or ride share service. Grand jurors may not claim reimbursements for alternative transportation costs in the same month the juror also received mileage reimbursements for the use of their own vehicle. This ordinance also authorizes the County Administrative Officer or designee to create and modify an alternative transportation policy for the Grand Jury.

The effective date of these changes will be thirty (30) days after adoption by the Board of Supervisors.

Attachment 2 Alternative Means of Transportation Policy

County of Tulare Grand Juror's Alternative Mobile Transportation Policy

A Grand Juror may request reimbursement for any of the following alternative mobile transportation methods used while carrying out their duties in any month the Grand Juror has not also requested and received reimbursement for mileage.

Requests for reimbursement for alternative mobile transportation shall be submitted in a manner consistent with requests for reimbursement for mileage.

Bicycles

A Grand Juror may request reimbursement for use of a bicycle at the California Department of Transportation allowable rate as shown in the Department's travel guide in effect at the time utilization occurred.

Public Transportation

A Grand Juror may request reimbursement for the use of public transportation up to the excludable gross income monthly amount for transit passes as set forth in the IRS Form 1099 instructions in effect at the time utilization occurred.

Taxi/Rideshare

A Grand Juror may request reimbursement for use of a taxi or a ride share such as Uber or Lyft if other transportation options are not available.
