<u>SUBJECT</u>: Approve a two year agreement with the Tulare County Office of Education and add one position allocation to the Sheriff's Office.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with the Tulare County Office of Education in the amount of \$182,437 (\$79,831 for year one and \$102,606 for year two), to provide law enforcement services outlined in the Tobacco Law Enforcement Prop 56 Grant program at designated school sites in Tulare County, retroactive from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020. The agreement is retroactive due to delays in negotiations.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2018 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the agreement.
- 4. Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).
- 5. Approve the attached personnel resolution

Add the following allocation: 1.0 FTE Sheriff's Deputy II

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6. If grant funding is not sufficient to fully fund this additional position in the future fiscal years, such position shall be deleted so as not to incur any Net County Cost, unless there are extenuating circumstances justifying retention of the affected positions and such position shall be approved by the Board of Supervisors.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Office of Education (TCOE) applied for the Tobacco Law Enforcement Prop 56 grant, effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020, as the lead agency and looked to the Sheriff's Office as a partner to support them with this grant; the funding request was to provide a Sheriff's Deputy II who will work with TCOE to support and assist in the facilitation of the Tobacco Law Enforcement Prop 56 Grant program by providing TCOE with services outlined in the grant. The goals and strategies of the Sheriff's Office are detailed in the agreement. The Sheriff's Deputy will work 40-hours a week with core hours Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 3:30pm. This position is unique in that education is the primary focus. The deputy will provide safety and security for staff and students at the designated school areas through campus policing. The deputy will enforce tobacco laws in coordination with TCOE and assist and collaborate in tobacco-related awareness/outreach activities at school events. With the support of TCOE, the Sheriff's Office will conduct retailer education classes focusing on prevention of the furnishing of tobacco products to minors; the Sheriff's Office will also assist with providing vendor/merchant scans within a 20 mile radius of the identified school sites to increase awareness of legal requirements of tobacco sales with a prevention-focused message. The deputy will report to the following school sites:

- Sundale School
- Buena Vista School
- Oak Valley School
- Palo Verde School
- Waukena Joint Union Elementary

The agreement is retroactive because the Sheriff's Office is providing services to TCOE and costs are being accrued. The Sheriff's Office began providing services on September 4, 2018, after the start of the 2018 school year, and will continue to provide services for the full 2019 school year. Due to delays in finalizing the agreement, the annual amounts will differ and the cost of services in 2018 has been prorated. Additionally, the Deputy Sheriff assigned to the grant program will utilize a vacant Sheriff's position, while the new grant position is being implemented. Once the new position has been established, the deputy will be transferred to the new position number designated for the grant. TCOE will reimburse the Sheriff's Office up to \$79,831 in grant funds for year one, and up to \$102,606 for year two once invoices are provided.

The agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The substantive deviations from the standard County boilerplate are: 1) the agreement provides for

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mutual indemnification, 2) it is a multi-year agreement, and 3) the agreement allows both parties to terminate without cause.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Tulare County Office of Education will reimburse the Sheriff's Office for one (1) FTE Deputy to include salaries, benefits and operating costs. The total agreement amount is \$182,437. Funds will be received on an annual basis for the term of the agreement. Expenses have been incurred and revenue is being generated for services provided in FY 2018/2019.

For the first year, September 4, 2018 to June 30, 2019, \$79,831 will be included in the Sheriff's FY 2018/2019 operating budget. Revenue and expenditures of \$79,831 of the program for FY 2018/2019 are reflected in the attached AUD 308.

An additional \$102,606, for August 12, 2019 to June 30, 2020 will be included in the Sheriff's proposed FY 2019/2020 operating budget. There is no net County cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year Strategic Business Plan and Management System include Safety and Security initiatives to provide for the safety and security of the public. This agreement will fulfill this initiative with the development of a FTE Deputy Sheriff that will provide safety and security through campus policing at the designated school sites and collaborate with other grant partners on tobacco related operations to prevent the furnishing of tobacco products to minors.
