**SUBJECT:** Terminate Local Emergency Adopted June 5, 2018

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Proclaim the termination of the Local Emergency due to Critical Shortage of Health Care Facilities.

**SUMMARY:**

The Board of Supervisors proclaimed a local emergency on June 5, 2018 as a result of the ongoing impacts to the local and regional healthcare system stemming from the closure of Tulare Regional Medical Center in October, 2017. This proclamation was made as part of an ongoing effort to secure assistance for the Tulare Local Healthcare District, including but not limited to financial assistance and regulatory relief.

Tulare Regional Medical Center reopened on October 15, 2018. As a result, the impacts across the local healthcare system are subsiding, and conditions warranting a continued local emergency no longer exist. Terminating the local emergency at this time satisfies the requirements of Government Code §8630(d) to proclaim the termination of a local emergency at the earliest practicable date that conditions warrant.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

There is no cost associated with terminating a proclamation of Local Emergency. There is no financial impact to any other organization or jurisdiction as no disaster assistance funding was received pursuant to this proclamation.
