Authorize the Tulare County Auditor to issue payment for the enhancement of the Transitional Living Center and Community

Living Center

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Tulare County Auditor to issue payment on behalf of the Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Mental Health Branch to the Housing Authority of Tulare County to complete the renovation and enhancement of the Transitional Living Center in an amount not to exceed \$225,000.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Mental Health Branch currently provides two transitional residential programs located in Visalia, the Transitional Living Center (TLC) and the Community Living Center (CLC). The Housing Authority of Tulare County owns these two facilities. To accommodate the recent expansion of the Centers from 36 to 53 beds, the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Tulare County Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Services and Support budget allotted \$600,000 in one-time funding specifically for facility improvements to TLC and CLC. The improvements include: TLC kitchen expansion to allow for increased food preparation area and storage, carport installation and asphalt improvements to create parking for more staff, new flooring and paint in all apartment units and community rooms to accommodate an increase in foot traffic and allow for uniform appearance throughout the facilities, pergolas to provide shade in the outdoor recreation areas, storm water removal, and security glass in reception area. This allotment was approved by the Board of Supervisors on

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May 1, 2018 (Board Resolution No. 2018-0291). After receiving bids, the costs exceeded the \$600,000 previously approved amount. An additional \$225,000 is needed to complete the project.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The additional expenses for the project, not to exceed \$225,000, has been included in the fiscal year 2018/2019 budget and will be paid through MHSA revenues. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote and encourage the provision of quality supportive services for individuals of Tulare County. The renovation will provide an environment more conducive to promoting wellness, recovery and resilience, as well as improving the quality of living for the residents of the Transitional Living Center and Community Living Center.
