SUBJECT:

Approve an agreement with the State of California, Secretary of

State

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with the State of California, Secretary of State in the amount of \$25,000 for reimbursement of funds for items related to the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) for county efforts to improve cyber security and infrastructure on a retroactive basis effective January 2, 2019 through June 30, 2021.
- 2. Find that the Board has the authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of January 2, 2019, it is in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four (4) copies of the Agreement.
- 4. Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).

SUMMARY:

The State of California, Secretary of State is offering reimbursement of funds for county efforts to improve cyber security and infrastructure to be administered by the U.S. Elections Administration Commission that comply with the requirements of HAVA Section 101 for the improvement of the administration of elections. The Election Assistance Commission (EAC) awarded the State of California \$34,558,874, to assist with activities to the administration of elections. Tulare County was allotted \$25,000.

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DATE: January 29, 2019

In order to be reimbursed, the County must conduct privacy and security awareness training for all staff utilizing the county voter registration and election information systems including cyber security best practices. The State is also allowing for reimbursement funds for the following: conducting security assessments; third party software and/or hardware in support of improving the county's cyber security capabilities related to VoteCal; software, hardware or consulting services and/or any associated IT installation directly related to cyber security risks; physically securing servers hosting county voter registration and election information system; properly updating and hardening servers hosting the county voter registration and election information systems; establishing, maintaining and participating in the dedicated VoteCal County Test Environment (CTE); services to improve security practices and documentation; monitoring systems and application to prevent and detect data breaches or fraud.

This agreement is retroactive due to the state not notifying our department of the award until mid-December 2018. Therefore, time did not allow for review by County Counsel and submittal to the Clerk of the Board to meet the States deadline. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate. First, the contract requires the County to unilaterally indemnify the state. Second, the contract requires the County to continue performing its responsibilities under the contract even if the County has a dispute with the state about the contract.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

As a result of receiving additional revenue allocated by the Secretary of State from Help America Vote Act (HAVA) funding, the attached AUD 308 requests revenue and expenditure increases totaling \$25,000. This funding is authorized to be used for county cyber security and infrastructure improvements.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's Five-year Strategic Plan includes the Organization Performance Initiative to continuously improve organizational effectiveness and fiscal stability. Approving an agreement with the State of California to accept grant funding helps fulfill this initiative by ensuring that staff is well trained in the area of cyber, privacy and security awareness, and the department has the equipment, materials, and educational information to get the job done.
