Approve the Excess of 10% for FY 2018-19 Vehicle Internal

Borrowing Program Purchase

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve the Excess of 10% for the purchase of 43 Ford Interceptors in the FY 2018-19 Vehicle Internal Borrowing Program.

SUMMARY:

On August 28, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Vehicle Internal Borrowing Program with the estimated cost of \$1,881,000. The authorization included the purchase of 43 Sheriff replacement vehicles and 13 Probation replacement vehicles. The authorized payment of those vehicles is through the utilization of the County's Vehicle Internal Borrowing Program which is made possible by a loan from the General Fund, not to exceed a 36-month period.

In Fiscal Year 2015, the County set aside \$3 million to fund the Vehicle Internal Borrowing Program for the future replacement of County vehicles. The \$3 million, along with the annual collection of payments for the participating departments has been sufficient to fund the Program on an ongoing basis.

For FY 2018-19 budgeted amount the available cost of 2019 Ford Interceptor vehicles was used, when County Purchasing placed the order only 2020 vehicles were available. The original price of a 2019 vehicle was budgeted at \$32,500, the 2020 price is \$37,183. This is a difference of \$4,683 per vehicle which is over the 10% capital asset threshold, per Administrative Regulation No. 4 Budgetary

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Program Purchase

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Controls.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no additional Net County Cost. There is available budget in the existing Vehicle Internal Borrowing Program to fund the additional 10% overage of \$201,369. The departments will be required to repay the General Fund in full within 36 months of the initial borrowing date. The required principal and interest payments at the Treasury Pool's annual interest rate, will be obtained by annual charges to the participating departments accounting line until the cost of the vehicles are fully amortized.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's Five-year strategic plan includes the Organizational Performance Initiative to provide for the stability of County operations through periods of economic fluctuations and changing priorities and service demands. The Vehicle Internal Borrowing Purchases for Fiscal Year 2018-19 helps fulfill this initiative by continuing to ensure the County's fiscal stability.
