**SUBJECT:** Approve an Agreement with Turning Point of Central California, Inc.  
– Visalia Reentry Center

**REQUEST(S):**  
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Turning Point of Central California, Inc., Visalia Reentry Center, for the provision of substance use residential services in the amount not to exceed \$232,228 effective February 26, 2019 through June 30, 2019; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

**SUMMARY:**  
Turning Point of Central California, Inc., provides adult residential substance use disorders treatment and recovery services. The Visalia Reentry Center (VRC) provides people with substance use disorders (SUD) the opportunity to live healthier lives through a safe and drug-free residence, group and individual counseling sessions focused on overcoming barriers caused by SUDs, and linkages to the community, which will enable clients to continue pursuing their recovery when they leave the program.

VRC utilizes cognitive-based therapy and evidence-based curriculum in treatment groups. The program conducts over 30 hours of treatment groups each week. The program focuses on treatment through individual and group counseling which may include drug education, cognitive thinking, anger management and parenting support groups.

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Visalia Reentry Center

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It is estimated that approximately 60 consumers will receive services through this agreement in Fiscal Year 2018/2019.


**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

Funding for this agreement in the amount not to exceed \$232,228 is included in the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 budget. This agreement is paid through the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation by providing drug and alcohol recovery treatment services to Tulare County adults.
