Approve the submission of a grant application for the 2019 Pet

Lover's Grant Program

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Ratify and authorize the submission of a Grant Application for the 2019 Pet Lover's Grant through the California Department of Food and Agriculture in the amount of \$50,000 to offer a voucher program for spaying and neutering owned animals along with administering a feral cat/TNR program, effective February 14, 2019; it was impracticable to get the grant application to the board prior to submission deadline.
- 2. Find that the Board has the authority to submit the application for the Pet Lover's grant as of February 14, 2019 and that it is in the County's best interest to apply for the grant; and
- 3. Ratify the signature of the Board Chairman on the 2019 Pet Lover's Grant Application Cover Page.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Animal Services (TCAS) opened in 2001. Since opening, Animal Services has worked diligently to increase its live release rates and assist the community with their personal pets. In 2017, Animal Services provided vaccination and microchip clinics throughout Tulare County. Earlier in 2019, Animal Services received a grant for spaying and neutering animals. The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) is offering grants through the pet lover's license plate program. Animal Services would like to apply for a \$50,000 grant to offer a voucher

program to spay and neuter owned animals along with administering a feral cat/TNR program. Vouchers will be redeemable at contracted veterinarians. Altered animals, in addition to not increasing the overall population through breeding, are more likely to stay home, and so in more than one way reduce the number of animals coming into the shelter.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this grant are included in the HHSA 6053 budget, line 7043, professional services for \$50,000. If awarded, the grant will be announced in May with funding in the 2018/2019 and 2019/2020 Fiscal Years. Animal Services will pay their contracted veterinarians and then be reimbursed through the state. Reimbursement from the state is either monthly or quarterly. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Organizational Performance initiative to continuously improve organizational effectiveness. By applying for this Grant through the CDFA, Animal Services department will be able to assist our constituents in spaying and neutering their companion animals along with feral cats.
