SUBJECT: Approval to increase the Capital Asset purchase of a thermal imaging camera system.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an increase of \$2,010 for the capital asset purchase of a thermal imaging camera system bringing the total cost to \$650,856.
- Authorize the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) is requesting approval to increase the expense for the capital asset purchase of a thermal imaging camera system for a TCSO aircraft, previously approved by Resolution No. 2018-0032 and 2018-0473.

TCSO had the vendor install the thermal imaging camera system on our Cessna T206H aircraft, which was recently completed. The camera is a compact lightweight, multi-sensor, fully digital, high definition thermal imaging camera system with zoom capability and exceptional picture clarity with target acquisition. The camera was integrated with a Sheriff's supplied operational Aero Computers Inc. UC6000 mapping system which allows for topography and street map overlay of the flight crews view. The two systems can be used day or night to identify heat sources such as missing children or Alzheimer's / dementia individuals, or vehicles.

The capital asset budget was based on the initial quote from the vendor. Once the vendor started the installation in the aircraft of the thermal imaging camera system

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and associated support equipment, the vendor and TCSO determined two additional user based components needed to be installed now to make the system more operationally efficient for the aircraft flight crew. These two components were not listed in the original bid documents or on the quote, and not listed on the scope of work.

Due to the unique Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements for vendor certifications and installation of any equipment in an aircraft, TCSO had the FAA certified vendor also install the needed components at the same time the thermal imaging camera system was being installed. Having the vendor who was already doing the system install, complete the additional installation of the two items, saved time and any technical complications by using a different vendor.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The additional funds of \$2,010 will come from the Sheriff's FY 18/19 operating budget. The total cost of the thermal imaging camera system, to include the labor and time to install the keyboard and radio components, will not exceed \$650,856. The budget adjustment (AUD 308) will shift funding from the maintenance equipment expense line to capital assets expense line. There will be no additional net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Organizational Performance Initiative to provide for the continuous improvement in organizational effectiveness. By having the approved installation vendor also install the additional components in the aircraft saved staff time and any potential technical complications that may arise from a different vendor working on the previous vendors installed equipment.
