REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the distribution of AB 109 Base Funding estimated at \$18,795,277 for FY 2018/2019.

SUMMARY:

In an effort to address overcrowding in California's prisons and assist in alleviating the state's financial crisis, the 2011 Public Safety Realignment Act (AB 109) was signed into law on April 4, 2011. AB 109 transferred the responsibility for the custodial housing and supervision of specified offenders from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to counties. Implementation of this legislation became effective October 1, 2011.

FY 2018/2019 Base Funding

The AB 109 Base Funding Allocation for Tulare County for FY 2018/2019 is estimated at \$18,795,277.

SUBJECT:Approve the Distribution of AB 109 Base Funding for FY 2018/2019DATE:March 26, 2019

On November 27, 2018, the Tulare County Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) unanimously approved a Base Funding distribution for FY 2018/2019. The CCP voted to allocate \$1,000,000 to the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) for Inmate Healthcare and \$765,697 for the Pre-Trial Court, \$380,410 for the District Attorney's Office, \$380,410 for the Public Defender's Office, and the remaining balance distributed equally between the Sheriff's Office and the Probation Department. Should there be any changes to the estimated Base Funding amount, the shares of the Sheriff's Office and the Probation Department will be adjusted accordingly.

FISCAL IMPACT / FINANCING:

The 2011 Public Safety Realignment Act projected Base Funding for FY 2018/2019 at \$18,795,277 is included in each department's FY 2018/2019 approved budget. There will be no net county cost associated with this request.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

County participation in the Local Community Corrections Plan aligns with the Strategic Initiative of Safety and Security in promoting crime prevention and providing facilities and resources for the training and rehabilitation of criminal offenders.
