Approve an agreement with the California State Association of

Counties

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with the California State Association of Counties in the amount not to exceed \$1,196,157 related to the Welfare Client Data Systems Consortium, effective April 9, 2019 through June 30, 2022; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency (HHSA) uses the CalWORKs Welfare Information Network application to determine the eligibility and benefit levels for multiple entitlement programs. This application also provides state reporting and other administrative information. HHSA is a member of the Welfare Client Data Systems Consortium for the operations and management of the CalWORKs Welfare Information Network application. The Welfare Client Data Systems Consortium establishes and maintains an ongoing working relationship with the California Department of Social Services, including monitoring of state and federal processing and review of Advance Planning Documents and feasibility studies. The Welfare Client Data Systems Consortium contracts for a consortium manager through the California State Association of Counties. This agreement will authorize Tulare County's proportionate share of the cost in funding the Welfare Client Data Systems Consortium operations management and staff to the California State Association of Counties as the contracting agent. In addition, this agreement allows HHSA to remain a member of the Welfare Client Data Systems consortium.

SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with the California State Association of Counties

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The CalWORKs Welfare Information Network system is used to serve approximately 50 percent of the population in Tulare County, which translates to 231,404 individuals.

Services are currently provided by the California State Association of Counties for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 through Tulare County Agreement No. 27753, which expires on June 30, 2019. The previous agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel and was approved by the Board of Supervisors on June 28, 2016. The purpose of this new agreement is to allow the continuance of these services through June 30, 2022.

The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate: (1) This is a multi-year term agreement; (2) All parties may terminate the agreement without cause upon 60 days written notice to CSAC through the Board of Directors; (3) The County may terminate the agreement due to loss of funds with 30 days' notice; (4) There is a mutual indemnification clause; (5) The County will sign first; (6) All legal actions to enforce the agreement must be brought in Sacramento County, California.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this agreement, not to exceed \$1,196,157, are included in the HHSA budget units 4030 and 4032 line 7043, professional services, Expenses for this agreement, and will be included in the Fiscal Year budgets in the following amounts: 2019/2020: \$680,683; 2020/2021: \$398,423; and 2021/2022: \$417,051. The funding is derived from a combination of State and Federal allocations for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, Title XIX Medi-Cal and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. There is no additional cost to the County General Fund.

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Organizational Performance initiative that provides state-of-the-art technology and infrastructure to support better service delivery. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill this obligation by continuing to provide access to the CalWORKs Welfare Information Network electronic eligibility determination system. TulareWORKs staff uses this system to determine client eligibility and benefit level for multiple social services programs.
